Course Description	This course is a continuation of Intermediate C and designed for students who have completed Intermediate courses at Korean Cultural Center, Los Angeles (KCCLA) or have the equivalent proficiency. This course will cover 12 chapters in the textbook as reviewing grammars and vocabularies related to subject assigned for each week. This class will mostly be conducted in Korean.

Week 2	Grammar: -겠-; -(으)ㄹ까요? Subject: weather, season
Week 3	Grammar: -는/(으)ㄴ/(으)ㄹ; 처럼 Subject: popular music and culture
Week 4	Grammar: -다가; -거든요 Subject: asking a direction on street

Week 5	Grammar: (이)라서; -아/어 주다/드리다 Subject: holidays, proper gift and present on specific holiday
Week 6	Grammar: A하고 B중에서; (이)라면 네/아니오 의문문 억양 Subject: shopping, making a purchase
Week 7	Grammar: 반말 1 (아/야); 반말 2 (-아/어) Subject: various activities in leisure time
Week 8	Grammar: 반말 3 (-자); 반말 4 ((이)야) Subject: making, changing, and confirming appointment
Week 9	Grammar: 반말 5 (-니/냐?); 반말 6 (-지; -(으)르게; -(으)르래; -군; -잖아) 의문사 의문문 억양 Subject: inquiring after a person and his/her health; paying respect
Week 10	Grammar: -기 바라다; 께 Subject: Korean traditional holiday and activities
Week 11	Grammar: -는데요; -기는 하다 Subject: asking a favor; declining politely
Week 12	Grammar: -게 하다/만들다; -(으)니까 Subject: expressing feeling and emotion properly
