North Jeolla Province Intangible Cultural Heritage Asset No.47 Free-Style Dance

**\*Sanjo Chum:** a Korean folk dance accompanied by Sanjo, a particular type of Korean folk music. Sanjo-chum was first created in the mid-twentieth century by many Korean dance choreographers and many different versions have kept the unique Korean dance style in that period.

**\*Honam** (Korean pronunciation: [ho.nam]; literally "south of the lake") is a region coinciding with the former Jeolla Province in what is now South Korea.
