

Presented by the *Korean Performing Art: Pansori Daroo*, "**THE ROAD**" will be held on Friday, September 9, 2016 at 7:30pm on the 3rd floor of Korean Cultural Center, Los Angeles in the Ari Hall.

Pansori (Korean: 판소리, also spelled p'ansori) is a Korean genre of musical storytelling performed by a vocalist and a drummer. The music is usually performed by one sorikkun (Korean: 소리꾼, a singer) and one gosu (a drummer playing a barrel drum called buk Korean: 북).

This program includes the traditional pansori "Chunghyo-ga (Danga)," "Dream song, Mangryeole (Heungtaryeong)," "Ipchechanggeuk 'Dosamaek' (Sugung-ga)," "Ttaraganda (Simcheong-ga)," "Neujeun Arirang (Namdominyo)" "Nongbu-ga (Chunghyang-ga)," "Dae Janggunbang (Heungbo-ga)," "Dongbaekkkot (Camellia flower)," "Nangamhane (Byeoljubujeon,", and "Arirang Medley."

"Daroo" Korean Performing Arts & Culture was founded in 2007 with a vision to bridge the gap between different cultural communities.

"Daroo" has been active in delivering and educating Korean traditional culture to the new generation and other cultures in the U.S.A. The main goal of "Daroo" is to travel around America and reach out to other cultural communities, Korean immigrants, and the new generation. Through the dedication embedded in our performances, we hope to touch the hearts of other ethnic groups to come together and inspire one another.

-PROGRAM-

1. Chunghyo-ga (Danga)

-Chunghyo-ga gives us a message that the root of the life is to take good care of your parents, and it also expresses loyalty and filial piety as the core elements of life.

2. Dream song, Mangryeole (Heungtaryeong)

-Well-known singer "Heungrok Song" in the Joseon Dynasty era composed this song to express his longing for his lover Mangryeole.

3. Ipchechanggeuk 'Dosamaek' (Sugung-ga)

-One day, the dragon king of the sea became very ill, and an ascetic advises that only a liver of a rabbit could cure him. And the king assigns the turtle to bring him a rabbit...

4. Ttaraganda (Simcheong-ga)

-A song that portrays how Simcheong feels as she sacrifices herself to heal her father's blindness.

5. Neujeun Arirang (Namdominyo)

-Arirang embraces the joys and sorrows of our forefathers who settled in Central Asia by passing through Baekdu mountain, North Gando.

6. Nongbu-ga (Chunghyang-ga)

- "Nongbu-ga" originated in the Joseon Dynasty era was sung by farmers to work with excitement and joy.

7. Dae Janggunbang (Heungbo-ga)

-This song is the beginning of Heungbo-ga as Heungbo's mean brother Nolbu becomes even more spiteful. This song is very comical and shows the sorrows of Heungbo with details of his poor situation at the same time.

8. Chohan-ga

-Chohan-ga, The history of King Pye in Qin Dynasty and the establishment of Hangojo in ancient China.

9. Dongbaekkkot (Camellia flower)

-It is a graceful song that expresses the comely appearance of camellias, and it conveys the love between young men and women using metaphorical lyrics.

10. Arirang Medley
