Los Angeles, CA — The Korean Cultural Center Los Angeles (Director Hae Don Lee) announced that acclaimed Korean filmmaker Park Chan-wook's latest film "No Other Choice" has been selected as the Opening Night film of the 11th Asian World Film Festival (AWFF), taking place from November 11 to 20 at the Culver Theater.

Founded in 2015, the Asian World Film Festival showcases outstanding films from across Asia and serves as a key platform for Oscar consideration, highlighting the diversity and artistry of Asian cinema. The Korean Cultural Center LA (KCCLA) has collaborated annually with AWFF to present Korean Oscar entries and notable features, fostering meaningful connections between the Korean and U.S. film industries.

- "The Prayer" (2025, Dir. Shin Joon, starring Kim Byung-chul, Song Ji-hyo, and Kim Hee-aura) International Premiere on November 15 at 9 PM

In addition, the "Koren Parallel Smartphone Film Festival" will feature four award-winning short films created by filmmakers with disabilities, celebrating diversity, creativity, and inclusion within the film community.

Director Hae Don Lee of KCCLA stated, "This year's program is especially meaningful as it brings together works by veteran directors, emerging creators, and disabled filmmakers, showcasing the full spectrum of Korean cinema. We hope local audiences in Los Angeles will experience the originality, depth, and inclusivity of contemporary Korean film."
