**Pansori** (from UNESCO site)

Pansori is a genre of musical storytelling performed by a vocalist and a drummer. This popular tradition, characterized by expressive singing, stylized speech, a repertory of narratives and gestures, embraces both elite and folk culture. Pansori has been inducted into UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage in 2003. (UNESCO website)

**Chunhyangga**

Chunhyangga is one of five surviving Pansori tales. It is the only love story between Sung Chunhyang and Yi Mongryong. Despite social class differences, they fell in love. Chunhyangga finishes with a happy ending. It is also a Korean folk tale.
