Korean Cultural Center Los Angeles (Director Jeong Sangwon), in collaboration with the Seoul Arts Center (SAC), will present the play "Hurrah for Women" on February 15th at 7:00 pm in the Ari Hall on the 3rd floor.

The play "Hurrah for Women" depicts the peculiar and thrilling cohabitation four women living together over a three-month period. It features the obedient yet strong-willed daughter-in-law, Seo-hee Choi, the traditional mother-in-law, Mrs. Hong and the free-spirited and assertive boarder, Yeo-ja Lee, and Mi-nam Hong, a 30-year-old actress striving to maintain her self-esteem and dignity. The arrival of the new boarder in the serene pond where three generations of women - mother-in-law, daughter-in-law, and granddaughter - live, creates a somewhat uncomfortable yet happy ripple by throwing a stone into the water.

"Hurrah for Women" tells a story of discrimination and sacrifice that any Korean woman can relate to. Simultaneously, it is a touching portrayal of the meaning of family and love discovered through life's struggles, resonating with all audiences regardless of gender or age. It's not merely a story for women, but a story to be shared with women.
