The Korean Cultural Center Los Angeles (KCCLA, Director Sangwon Jung) will hold a "Korean Night" on Thursday, August 18th at the Skirball Cultural Center located at 2701 N. Sepulveda Blvd., Los Angeles CA 90049. The event will run from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.

This event has been prepared in collaboration with the Skirball Cultural Center—a representative cultural space in Los Angeles—as part of the free, annual "Sunset Concert Series" and this year will mark the 25th anniversary of the series.
