April 12, 2022 - Los Angeles, CA – The Korean Cultural Center Los Angeles (KCCLA) will present a special performance, **Flashpoint 429**, in Ari Hall. (5505 Wilshire Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90036), on Friday, April 29th, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. Tickets are free but reservations are required.

Flashpoint 429 is a concert that brings together community leaders and musicians to commemorate the 30th Anniversary of the LA Uprising / 429 (April 29). First, we will have Emile Mack, retired LAFD Deputy Chief, join as a speaker. Mr. Mack is a Korean adoptee who was raised by an African American family. Next, Lora King, daughter of Rodney King, will deliver a message about the LA Riot via video.

For musicians, Miljenko Matijević, who has millions of fans worldwide and is an all-time favorite rocker among many Koreans, will play at **Flashpoint 429**.
